## **Wildfire Prevention Tips**

Wildfires can start due to climate, the season, vegetation, topography and the weather. Here are a few things you can do to keep your home safe:

- Be sure to keep your roof free of dried vegetation, especially pine needles and dried leaves.
- Water and cut your lawn regularly to avoid dried grass and vegetation.
- Always extinguish cigarettes or tobacco products properly and never throw them into a wooded area.
- Be sure to have working smoke alarms in your home and test them monthly. Also equip your home with a fire extinguisher and know how to properly use it.
- Plan and practice your family's escape plan. Know your family meeting place and practice it at least two times per year.
- Only use fireworks in designated areas.
- Teach children never to play with matches or lighters. If they see them, they should ask a grown up to put them away.
