
From the Chief:

The Police Department has received a request for action and numerous complaints from our citizens concerning speeding vehicles during peak morning traffic hours in the area of Hoffman Hill, Ridgeview and Brown Avenues. There is concern for pedestrian safety, especially with the many school children in the area. Yesterday, on January 16, we started a traffic enforcement emphasis program in the area, focusing on Ridgeview between McNeil and Brown Streets. We will continue this emphasis until January 30th- mainly in the morning hours, in an attempt to slow traffic down and keep the roads safe.

What this means is that officers will be high profile in the areas listed above- we won't be hiding! We would appreciate as much citizen cooperation over this issue as possible, to prevent accidents and injuries from occurring.
