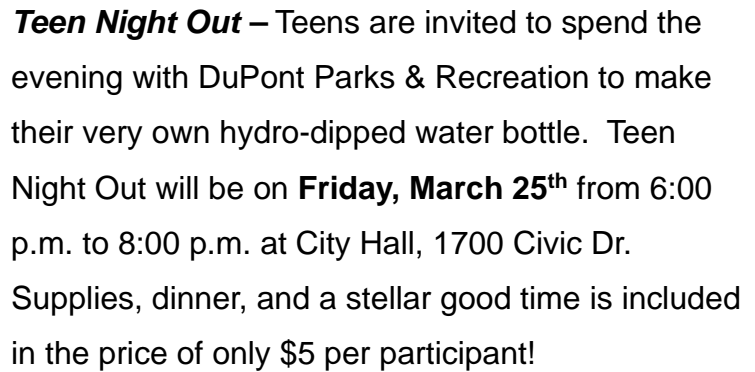

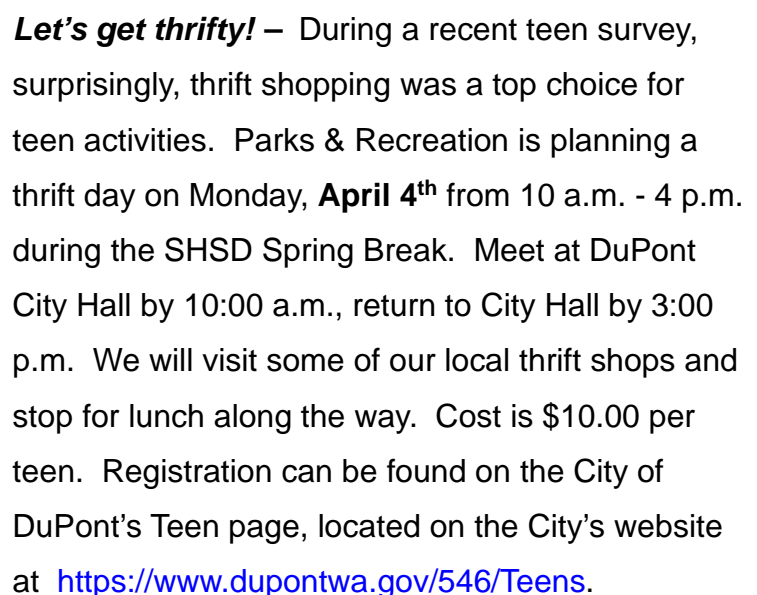

Safety Tip-Before you Doze, Close the Door

- ✓ Doze Safely
 - Approximately 50% of home fires happen between 11 p.m. and 7 a.m. Close your bedroom door before you go to sleep.
- ✓ Take it Down a Notch
 - During a fire, a closed door can keep carbon monoxide levels 90% lower than if the door is left open.
- ✓ Make a 900 Degree Difference
 - A closed door during a fire can mean reducing 1,000 degrees down to 100 degrees.
- ✓ Take a Breather
 - A fire needs oxygen to burn. A closed door keeps more oxygen in the room and away from the fire. When you exit a fire, close doors behind you to slow its growth.
