August 8th Press Release: Two DuPont Structures Destroyed by Fire – No reported injuries

On August 6, 2022, at approximately 4:29 p.m., multiple agencies were dispatched to a reported structure fire involving two (2) homes at 1370 Brackenridge Ave., Dupont, WA. There were multiple callers reporting both structures were involved. During the same time as the fire was dispatched, the entire DuPont Fire on-duty shift was on the scene of a medical call with a 2-year-old who was experiencing a serious medical event.
