## **ATTENTION DUPONT HYUNDAI OWNERS - FREE ANTI-THEFT DEVICE NOW AVAILABLE AT DPD:**

In 2022, over 45,000 vehicles were stolen in the state of Washington. According to the Puget Sound Auto Task Force, in December alone, 972 vehicles were reported stolen in Pierce County. Many of the vehicles affected were Hyundai models with hard key ignitions. It is believed the thefts began after social media videos posted last year showed step-by-step instructions on how to steal both Hyundai and Kia vehicles.

In response to the thefts, Hyundai is working with select law enforcement agencies throughout the country, including the DuPont Police Department, to provide FREE steering wheel locks to owners of the impacted Hyundai models to help deter further thefts.

Any resident of DuPont who owns a Hyundai vehicle with a hard key ignition may pick up a FREE steering wheel lock (while supplies last) Monday through Friday from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm at the DuPont Police Station. Please bring your current registration as proof of ownership.

Hyundai has also taken additional steps to prevent thefts of the impacted vehicles, including an upcoming software upgrade that will be made available to vehicle owners starting in March at no cost. For more information, contact your local Hyundai dealership.
