WHO DO I CALL?



South Sound 9-1-1 dispatches both emergency and non-emergency calls for the DuPont Police Department. Dispatchers are available to answer your call 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Call if you can, text if you can't!

Not sure which number to call? Dial 9-1-1!

- Have an emergency?
- Do you need to report an in progress crime or incident?
- Do you notice something or someone suspicious in the area?

Dial 9-1-1

- Do you need to speak with an officer about a non-urgent matter?
- Is there an incident that already occurred you would like to report?

Dial 253-287-4455

Have an emergency but are unable to speak? Text 9-1-1

(1) Open a new text message (2) Enter the numbers 9-1-1 in the To: field
(2) Type a brief message including description of the emergency and location (4) Press send
