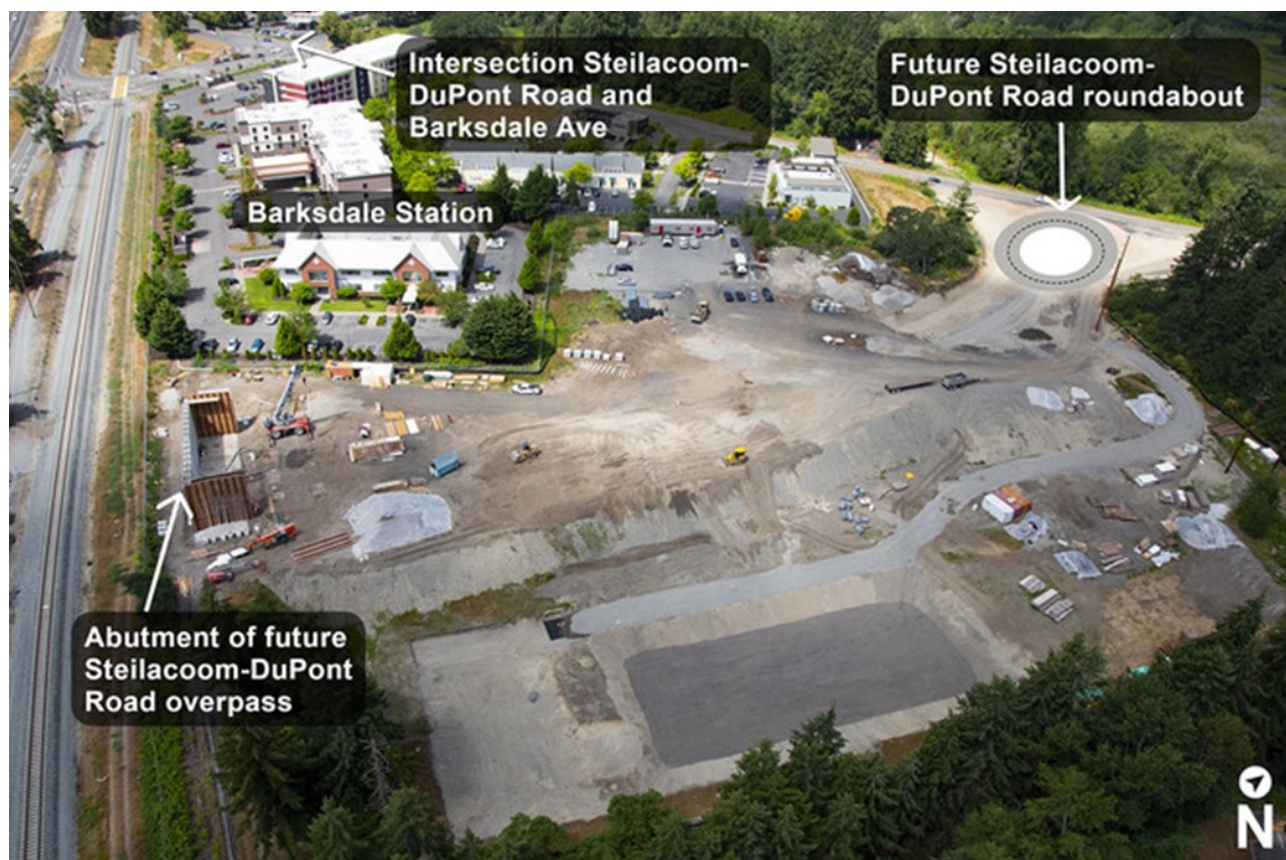
## WSDOT: I-5 corridor improvements project near Joint Base Lewis-McChord hits one-year milestone and shifts into new stage



We're that much closer to a new and improved Interstate 5 near JBLM!

Since August 2023, construction crews have been working hard near DuPont. They have been constructing the foundations for major upgrades to I-5. There has been a lot of other work to improve how people get to the interstate and how they get onto the highway.

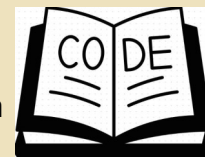
### Building Code Q & A:

**Question:** If I re-roof my home, and the roof sheathing does not meet the current code requirements, does it need to be replaced?

**Answer:** No. As long as it met the adopted code at the time of construction and is in good condition, the roof sheathing does not need to be replaced.

Code Section: R4503.2.2 Existing Materials

Materials already in use in a building in compliance with requirements or approvals in effect at the time of their erection or installation shall be permitted to remain in use unless determined by the building official to be unsafe.

## Safety Message - Outdoor Cooking & Grilling Safety

In 2022 Washington State fire departments responded to more than 6,000 natural vegetation fire incidents which included wildland fires. More than 2,000 of those calls were related to outdoor cooking and grilling.

The State Fire Marshal's Office urges residents to keep outdoor grilling safe all weekend long and avoid contributing to an already very busy weekend for our fire service personnel. Ensure compliance with local burning restrictions which may restrict or prohibit the use of open flames and grills.

- Place portable grills outside at least 3 feet away from flammable materials including, fences, deck railings and exterior siding.
- Keep children and pets at least 3 feet away from hot grills.
- Clean the grill and maintain it free from the accumulation of grease and fat buildup.
- Stay by the grill while it is lit and watch what you are cooking.
- Use long handled cooking utensils to prevent burns. Keep loose sleeves rolled up to prevent contact with the hot grill and possible ignition.
- When turning off gas grills, close the valve at the tank and close the lid.
- When finished with a charcoal grill, ensure the coals are fully extinguished and cool before placing them in a metal container.
- Allow grills to cool fully before covering or putting away.

### NEWS FROM PATROL

Officers responded to a call at a local business for an unwanted customer. After confirming the identity of the customer, it was discovered that he had a warrant from Lakewood Police Department for False Reporting in the 3Rd Degree. During a frisk search, a syringe was found in the customer’s clothing. If the contents of the syringe test positive for methamphetamine, additional charges will be referred to the Prosecutor. 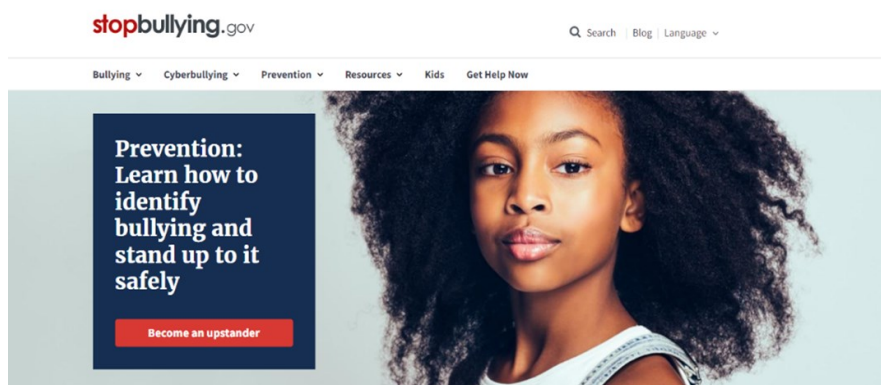

### Stop Bullying on the Spot

When adults respond quickly and consistently to bullying behavior they send the message that it is not acceptable. Research shows this can stop bullying behavior over time.
