## **NEWS FROM PATROL**

- Officers were dispatched to a physical domestic violence incident between spouses. After arriving on scene and interviewing both individuals, the female half was arrested for Assault In the 4<sup>th</sup> Degree.
- A resident reported damage that had occurred to their vehicle. It appears that someone damaged the lock in an attempt to enter the vehicle.
- Officers were dispatched to an attempted suicide. An individual attempted to harm themselves by driving their vehicle head on into a tree. The individual was transported to the hospital.
- The Thurston County Sheriff's Office was pursuing possible burglary suspects on I-5. DuPont officers were requested to assist with locating the vehicle after it had entered DuPont.
- Officers received a report of a motor vehicle theft. The owner was able to track the vehicle using an air tag. The vehicle was located in the city and returned to the owner.
