NEWS FROM PATROL

- While on patrol, officers observed a driver on Steilacoom DuPont Road driving erratically and at a high rate of speed. After a traffic stop and subsequent investigation, it was determined that the driver was more than double the legal limit of alcohol. The driver was arrested and booked into jail for DUI.
- Officers assisted the Pierce County Sheriff's Department with a vehicle collision involving injuries on Mounts Road.
- Officers were dispatched to check on a demonstration that involved a large number of people on the Center Drive overpass. The demonstration was found to be peaceful.
- Washington State Patrol (WSP) requested assistance from DuPont officers with locating a possible intoxicated driver that crashed their vehicle on I-5. The driver was located and arrested by WSP on multiple charges.
- Officers responded to an attempted suicide. The individual involved was conscious and transported to a local hospital for treatment.
- DuPont officers assisted with a multi-vehicle accident on I-5.
- A resident reported the theft of their vehicle. The vehicle was recovered in a neighboring city. Several days later, the same resident reported another vehicle stolen from the same location. It was determined that the keys to the second stolen car had been left in the first one.

DEPARTMENT NEWS

- Members of the DPD participated in the City of DuPont Downtown Trick or Treat event. Officers provided public safety and traffic control.
- Additional patrols were conducted in residential areas to provide safety on Halloween during trick or treating.
- A Speed emphasis was conducted on McNeil Street.
- Officers were present for a veteran's event at a local retirement community.
- Officers completed required online training.
- Students and staff at local schools were greeted by officers.
