In 2024, we received 324,617 calls to our non-emergency line!

Use the non-emergency line instead of 911 when there's no immediate threat to life or property, the situation has ended, and there's no chance of catching the suspect.

Here are some examples:

- You discovered your car was broken into, but didn't witness it.
- Your runaway child has returned home.
- You need to add more details to a burglary report you already filed.
- Your car or bike was stolen sometime earlier in the day or night.
