DuPont Municipal Code 9.12 pertaining to Fireworks was amended in February of 2024

It is now illegal to use, discharge, or explode any fireworks within the City of DuPont at any time. This includes “safe and sane” fireworks such as fountains and sparklers that can be purchased in nearby cities.
