- Officers assisted Washington State Patrol with responding to a domestic violence incident. The victim, who was also the passenger in a vehicle with their spouse, called 911 for police assistance while on I-5. The vehicle entered DuPont and parked at a local business. DuPont officers were able to locate the vehicle and interview both spouses. Officers arrested the male half for Domestic Violence Assault in the 4<sup>th</sup> Degree and Malicious Mischief in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree.
- A speed emphasis was conducted on Steilacoom DuPont Road and Center Drive.
- Officers provided public safety and traffic control at the City of DuPont Downtown Trick or Treat event.
