On behalf of the Applicant, the City of DuPont, we are submitting this request for variance on the Public Works Facility – North Site, as covered under DuPont Municipal Code (DMC) Chapter 25.160, Variances. We previously submitted a request for variances from three City codes with a letter dated February 27, 2020. We are requesting a fourth variance to the following specific code:

- 4) Chapter 25.35, Mixed Use District, DMC 25.35.050, Building Setback Restrictions, Part (1) “The front yard setback shall be between zero and 20 feet, except when across the street from a residential district, in which case it shall be that of the adjoining residential district”

REQUEST FOR VARIANCE 4: DMC 25.35.050(1) – FRONT YARD SETBACK
